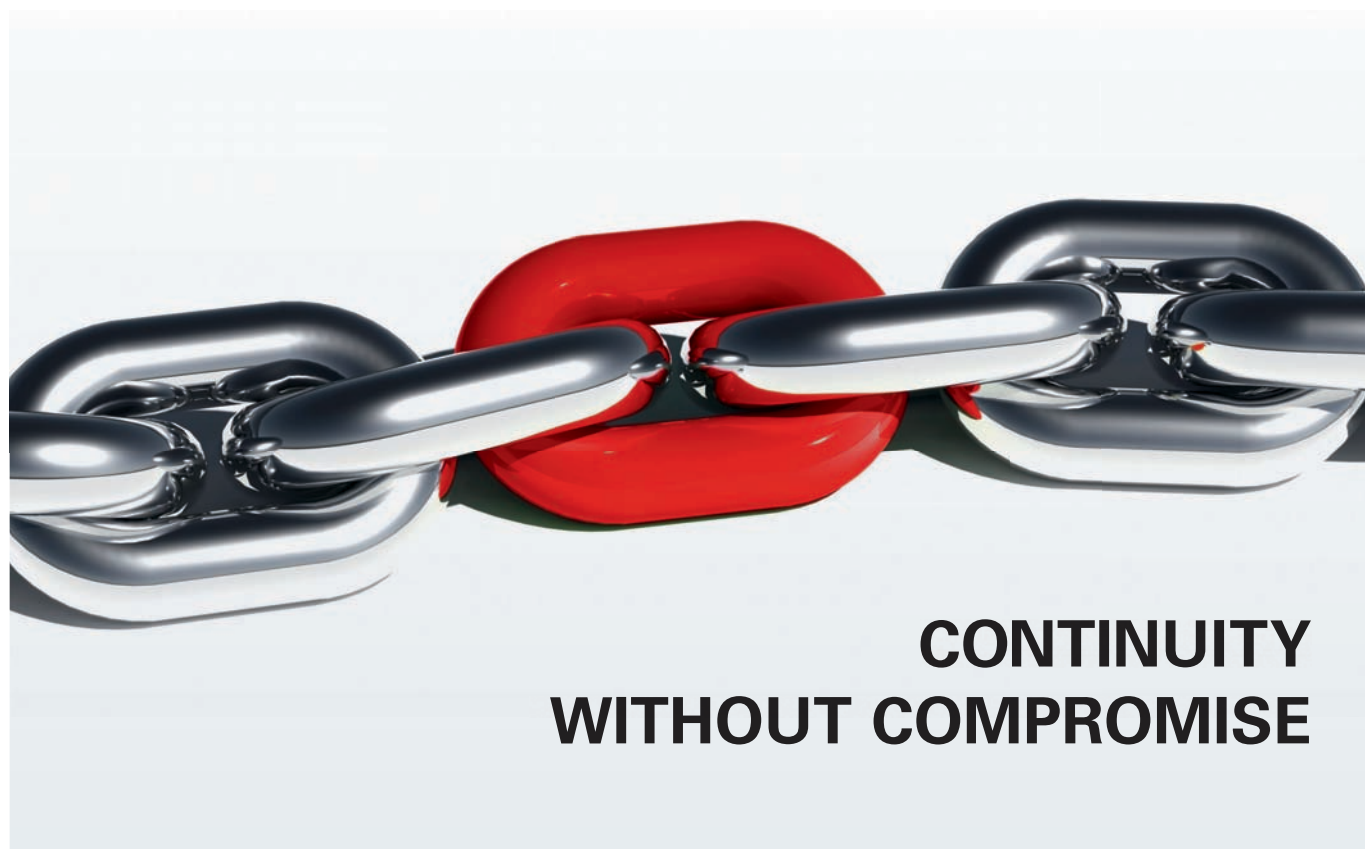

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HIGH-AVAILABILITY BUSINESS

Good data management, with protection from data loss and downtime, is key to keeping your business running in the event of an outage. But it can improve your productivity too – and increase your competitive advantage.

Recent headlines about lost data and careless information management in government departments and businesses only tell part of the story. As consumers, these incidents worry us all – but the companies concerned can face hefty costs too. A recent retail study by research company Gartner found that 21 of the 50 companies surveyed had suffered a data breach. Examples included phishing attacks, lost or stolen laptops, and attacks by hackers and insiders. Most, however, hadn't told their customers for fear of losing business. And most were either fined or threatened with fines by credit card companies for non-compliance with industry regulations.

DOWNTIME – A MAJOR BUSINESS RISK

The costs of data loss and downtime are a burden for any organisation. Companies are all competing for market share, mindshare and customers. Because of their heightened agility, midsize firms can often react faster to customer demands than their large competitors. However, a period of unavailability may result in customers going elsewhere. Yet losing a customer is just one part of the cost. A quick search on the web reveals dozens of ways of calculating the cost of downtime. Depending on the business, losses can range from \$1,000 per hour to \$100,000 or more. Added to that are the hidden elements like lost productivity and customer confidence, penalty payments, and hiring equipment and staff to deal with the crisis. From these facts it's clear to see that preventing an incident like this is vital to midsize organisations.

PREVENTION IS BETTER THAN CURE

You might have disaster recovery plans in place – and that's clearly essential. So why should you think about a business continuity strategy as well? Because

where recovery is focused on one event, business continuity looks at preventing it and limiting the damage if it does happen. 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TALKING POINT: KEEPING YOUR BUSINESS RUNNING

Taking precautions against data loss and downtime make great business sense for midsize organisations. **Eftychia Frangeskou** tells us what they should look out for.

Q: HOW WIDESPREAD IS DATA LOSS AND DOWNTIME AT MIDSIZE ORGANISATIONS?

A: It often goes unreported, so it's hard to quantify. But a 2007 study by the research group IDC showed that 92 per cent of European midsize companies had experienced laptop theft in 2007 and 54 per cent in the previous six months. They also said 58 per cent of the cost of data loss isn't hardware-related. The consequence is that the users concerned are less productive – it can take days to replace a laptop. And the loss of sensitive information, resulting in decreased customer confidence, can be devastating. These figures are bad, even without losses from other causes, such as a system crash.

Q: DOES THAT MEAN COMPANIES SHOULD BE SPENDING MORE ON SECURITY?

A: That should certainly be a priority. But it's not just about security. Why? Because companies with limited IT budgets will get a better return on investment with better data management and business continuity strategies. That way, they can address these security issues while minimising downtime and ensuring quick recovery if systems do crash. They can adopt a data management approach that incorporates both security and business continuity. This helps them benefit from an increase in internal efficiency and cut IT costs. It makes good business sense.

Q: ISN'T IT COMPLEX TO IMPLEMENT BUSINESS CONTINUITY?

A: It doesn't have to be! Oracle Database 11g forms the basis of efficient data management and comes with multiple security features as standard. Then we offer other options for business continuity.

The first of these is Oracle Real Application Clusters (RAC). This spreads your database and applications across a cluster of servers rather than just one.
